

## Abstract

This research intends to point out the specific conditions for the existence of the wholesaler of sun-dried fishes in Tha Tian district, an old area of inner Bangkok. The finding shows three important conditions. The first condition is the centrality of the area. The important aspects of this centrality being the place for the change in modes of transportation, between land and water transportation, and the accessibility to production resources and wholesale customers. The second condition is the economic relations among the wholesalers which are maintained through their embeddedness in social relations, specifically kinship and neighbour. The third condition is the realization of this group of wholesalers that their spatial practices related by their occupations and their private lives are being threatened by the spatial practices concerning the master Plan of KrungRatanaKosin.
